The first ten (10) miles of the Escheats build have been completed by TermLink. REA Energy and In The Stix are estimating that all builds for the ring will be completed by end of 2025. REA Energy's marketing team sent out approximately 185 postcards to potential customers in the Cambria County area this month and will continue to market as more phases of the build are completed. Two (2) used splicing vans have been purchased for ITX.
